Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University is fully residential **India's First State Private Women's University**, established and incorporated under the Act 17 of 2008 passed by Rajasthan State Legislature and notified by the Government of Rajasthan through its official Gazette Notification No. F.2 (23) Vidhi /2/2008 dated April 21, 2008.

University prohibits the use of mobile phone in University campus. 


Figure 2 Campus View

4. Village Adoption & Rural upliftment: By Adopting 5 villages in University surrounding, University executing Village Development Plan which serve Health, Education, Legal & Agriculture mentorship to each and every home & schools in nearby villages resulting in higher standard of living & sustainable livelihood. With the establishment of Bank, Post Office, Hospitals, Community Radio Station & other basic amenities for general public marked for upliftment of nearby community.

A groups of Women from each adopted villages provide the training by Teacher and students mentors for production of products and items as specified for particular villages under University Startup recognized by Startup India namely Mahila Samuh Gramodhyog", & "Maa Rasoi"" by using their traditional skills and methods and utilize their free time.

Each adopted Villages selected to produce minimum 1 homemade product and 1 handicraft or handmade items.

- a) Village Jharna is for Papad Badi and Gau Dhupbatti Diya
- b) Village Keshrisinghpura for Vinegar and Handmade items
- c) Village Kapadiyawas for Sauce / Chautney & for Compost Insect Repellent
- d) Village Kotejewar for Murabba Jam & Blue Pottery Terracotta
- e) Village Devla for pickle and khadi items.

5. Employment Generation: Implemented reservation policy in recruitment on all the posts since past 12 years.
 - 60% posts are reserved for the reserved categories residing within 20 Kms of radius of University surrounding villages -
 - 30% posts are reserved for Women, having Domicile in Rajasthan.

6. Prevent Dropout Ratio: To encourage local girl's aspirants for higher education and prevent dropouts, .
 -Introduced reservation policy for local girl aspirants namely **"Local Academic Seats"** to promote them for higher education to prevent dropouts & migration from University surrounding rural areas.
 -25% intake is reserved in each program with maximum possible subsidized fee structure for local community so that maximum numbers of girls may get enrolled in professional & Technical Programs

7. Recognition of Local Identities: We emphasis on giving recognition to local identities of plants, food products, traditions, medicines etc. He strongly believes that geotagging of local identities should be done so that they could be identified and recognized by their place of origin. He has established "Local Research Resource Centre" to recognize Regional /Rural Technologies, Traditional Medicine & Therapies, Traditional customs & rituals for correlation & integration with ancient Indian literature and modern scientific techniques for Scholars and Academic tourists.

8. 'Nationalism' Building a sense of patriotism and a habit to express affection for the Nation by incorporating practices of National importance and perform National Anthem & National Song everyday .

9. Waste Management: Developed the practice of waste management through recycling and concern towards environment al protection. University practice Self Disposal of Garbage and transform into useful products on the concept of 'Punar Janam' Ready to Serve Again



10. Moral & Social Values: Inculcating the habit of morale and social values among students by continuous evaluation through “My Behavior & Ethics”.

University adopted the respectful gesture of greeting by Saying 'Namaste' to everyone and Elders give blessing by saying "Khush Raho Bitiya' & Practicing Forgiveness by saying "Mujhe Chhama Daaan Karein "

11. Environment Protection: Developed the practice of waste management through recycling and concern towards environment by “Patra Daan Karen” evam “Patra Paudha Prapt Karen”.

Developed 'My Birthday Garden' to strengthen the 'JVWU' bond with nature for environmental protection by 'planting of saplings' in University “My Birthday Garden” to promote green practices.



12. Participating Institution” (PI) of UBA: University has been Recognized by Government of India under “Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan” by selecting as “Participating Institution” (PI) in 2018 for the development of University’s adopted villages namely “Jharna, Devla, Keshrisinghpura, Kapadiyawaas and Kotjewar” for working on a village development project.



13. Local Research Resource Centre: University established “Local Research Resource Centre” to recognize Regional /Rural Technologies, Traditional Medicine & Therapies, Traditional customs & rituals for correlation & integration with ancient Indian literature and modern scientific techniques/knowledge for regional, National & International scholars/students/teachers and Academic tourists. University Local Staff members are share knowledge and give their inputs for local and regional Research Resource.

14. University Community Radio Station: Literacy and Awareness programs being broadcast on the University Community Radio Station- Jayoti Vani for Promotion of traditional culture, communication and information about Government & University Policies in relation to Health, Education, Agriculture & Employment opportunities etc. apart from this, University organize awareness camps, rally, nukkad natak in surrounding villages to aware villagers about various Government policies related to Health, Education, Agriculture etc.



15. Medical Services University 100 Bedded AYUSH Hospital 'Suryansh Arogyashala' and other associated units of University is providing extension services in the field of Medical & Health Care in the surrounding villages and established Village Development Centers in adopted villages to cater the health issues of the villagers. University is having 6 Village Development Centres (VDCs), 8 Private Health Centres (PHCs) and Integrated Facility Centre (IFC) located at Village - Mahala. and acts as a referral hospital for its VDCs and PHCs.

16. During COVID Pandemic, University AYUSH Hospital and other buildings are declared as "500 Bedded Quarantine Centre" by the State Government and serve a community for a social cause .

1. Distributed Arsenic Album and Ayurvedic Medicine to 2504 University girl students, 373 University staff and 603 residents of University adopted villages as Immunity Booster.
2. Distributed Arsenic Album 30 to approximately 5000 residents of villages (Dudu division) with the Government Department. After its success Government declared the "Khajpura Model" due to Immunity boosting and breaking the Corona Chain and its spread. Govt repeat the model to 1010 residents of the nearby village Boraj to break the Corona Chain and its spread.
3. Donation of 11,00,000/- (Eleven Lakh Rupees) and food packets to Relief Fund of Government of Rajasthan.
4. Total 11 research papers published on COVID 19 Management out of which 2 research papers published on Clinical Management sent to AYUSH ministry & ICMAR for further approval of clinical Trial.
